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# Why Read in the Summer?

Students who do NOT read in the summer lose over two months of academic progress.

Don't lose what you have worked hard all year to gain!









### **Good News!**



Reading just 5 books this summer will prevent summer learning loss.



# Why Read in the Summer?

Reading for as little as 6 minutes can reduce stress by 60%.







# Why Read in the Summer?

Reading helps improve **memory**, **focus**, and **concentration**!

Students who read 20 minutes a day throughout the year tend to score at or above the 90% percentile on standardized tests.


